## 1. Cultural Materials

We have Japanese cultural materials for lending aiming at introducing Japanese culture and promoting friendship between Japan and other countries.

## 2. Conditions

<Events and activities that the materials could be borrowed for>

- (1) Events and activities aiming at introducing Japanese culture to Egyptian (and other countries) people
- (2) Events and activities aiming at developing Japanese language education
- (3) Events and activities aiming at cultural, academic and artistic exchange between Japan and Egypt (and other countries).
- (4) Other events and activities that the Japan Foundation Cairo Office permits

<Events and activities that can NOT borrow the materials for>

- (1) Profitable events and activities aiming at selling goods and commercial promotion
- (2) Religious and political events and activities
- (3) Events and activities that might break the peace of JF or the public
- (4) Other events and activities that the Japan Foundation Cairo Office does not permit

<Terms and conditions>

- (1) Application must be submitted one month at least prior to the beginning date of the event or activity
- (2) Applications from individuals are not accepted
- (3) In principle, borrower has to come to our office to pick up the materials (postal service is not available)
- (4) Materials should not be lent to a third party, or borrowed for a third party
- (5) In case of losing or damaging any of the borrowed materials, the Japan Foundation retains the right to ask for a suitable compensation in return.
